Mosqueda Bike Park Opens

The biggest bike facility in the country at 30,000 square feet also boasts a 19-foot cradle

Fresno, CA (July 6, 2009) – After five years of planning and construction work the 30,000 square foot Mosqueda Bike Park, the biggest facility in the country for bikes and is located in Fresno, is now open.

It was a festive event, with dignitaries such as Fresno City Council Member Mike Dages, PARCS Director Randy Cooper, and Fresno Convention and Visitors Bureau President and CEO Jeff Eben attending. Demonstrations were held by BMXers, some of whom accepted the challenge of the one-of-a-kind 19-foot cradle, which causes the rider to flip upside down. There was also a competition sponsored by Herb Bauer for top five freestyle contest winners, with a cash purse of \$1,800.

The planning for the park began in late 2004 and early 2005 with several community meetings coordinated by the City of Fresno Parks, After School, Recreation and Community Services Department. With the input of both BMXers and sports enthusiasts, as well as working with clay to try and make a model of the ideal skate park, Wormhoudt, Inc. was able to design the facility, the nation's largest with 30,000 square feet of concrete.

The Mosqueda Bike Park is the only place for miles where BMXers can take advantage of a place that is designed just for their bikes.
