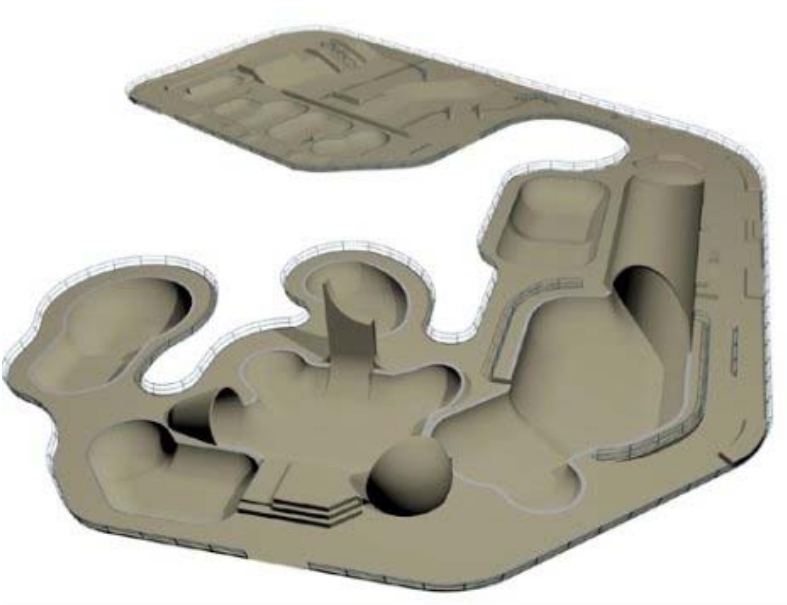


Web Urbanist: San Jose and Louisville ranked two of the World's Top Skate Parks
